How Pay-to-Plays Parties Work

- "Hosts" organize their "parties" (teddy bear tea, sommelier tasting, art workshop), complete, and submit a *Pay-to-Play Host Form* to the Donation Chair. The Party will then be available at the Auction (online and/or at event) for sign-up.
- Event attendees/bidders sign up and "pay to play" or participate in a given party. The parties can be any activity or theme -- wine pairing dinner for 5 couples, mountain biking tour for 10 families, a Hoedown for 100 guests, etc.
- Party sign-ups are first come, first served and some sell out very quickly!
- Hosts are responsible for all expenses pertaining to their Party (suggested cost per host less than \$150).
- After the Auction, Hosts will be provided with contact information for those who have signed up for their Party. The Hosts are then responsible for all follow up, communication, and organization regarding their Party, in addition to hosting the event on the specified date.
- Volunteer hours are given for planning and organizing Pay-to-Play Parties.
- Pay-to-Play Parties are AWESOME!
